Participation in the conference is **free**.



- ✓ Abstracts volume up to **5 pages** with A4 page format (297x210 mm), orientation book page;
- ✓ The text must be typed in the text editor MS Word (extension .docx, .doc, .rtf).
- ✓ Page parameters: A4 format, all margins 2 cm, without page numbers.
- ✓ Text font Times New Roman, lines without hyphenation.
- ✓ Parameters of the main text paragraph:
- text alignment width;
- line spacing 1 pt.;
- indent for the first line 1.25 cm;
- paragraph spacing 0 pt.

Headers, footers and footnotes are not applied in the document.

✓ <u>The first line (bold font, all uppercase letters, aligned in the center) - the title of the abstract;</u> <u>second line</u> (bold italic font, center alignment) - author's surname and initials; <u>third line</u> (italic font, center alignment) - educational institution or place of work, city, country.
